15		Walk to coffee Waag	Aalmarkt 21: 1658
		Maarsmansteeg V&D 1906 First shopping centre in Leiden. In 1934 new larger building. At the corner of the building images with birds and parents/children to indicate that the shopping centre belongs to the entire family. The leaded windows are original.	
10.00		Coffee at Bagels & Beans Maarsmansteeg 8 Small lane next to V&D 1905 architect Jesse & Fontein (see name in plint). Formerly Coatshop Buns & Akkerman. Jugendstil. Iron skeleton with glass, because no pillars in building were allowed. Tower was originally covered with gold painted lead.	
10.45		walking tour	Leiden: old city has 1320 historical buildings and the most historical buildings/km2. Important city in 17th century with cloth production. A city of refugees: 13+14 th century Flemish; 16 th cent French; 17 th cent English Pilgrim Fathers (in 1620 to USA; co-founders of USA); Germans; 18 th cent Huguenots; Leiden has first university of The Netherlands, founded by Willem van Oranje.
		Almshouses: Open 9.30-17.30, small groups allowed	Since 12th century. For the beguine of the church and for poor people. Often built by rich people. Leiden has 35 almshouses due to the textile industry (many rich traders). They could name an almhouse to themselves for eternity. Mostly his portrait was in the trustees room (Regentenkamer). Sometimes the inhabitants had to pray for the founder of the almshouse. Often generations of the family managed the almshouse. Sometimes the gate is large, sometimes it is in between small houses.
		Vismark 4 Opposite of B&B Iron structure Jugendstil. Curved windows and coloured brick.

	<p>Breestraat 52</p> <p>1933 in style of New Realism. Steel skeleton with concrete floors. Blue steel windows. Top of tower consists of milk glass. Yellow brick at outside. Comparable to Hilversum town hall with deep Dudok horizontal joints and flat vertical joints. Increases the feeling of length when sunlight is present.</p>	
	<p>Cityhall with Roepstoel</p>	<p>3 okt 1574 Mayor Van der Werff announced the retrieval of the Spain</p>
	<p>Breestraat/Pieterskerk Choorsteeg</p>	<p>At the corner in the road deck the six sided stone, where the executioner did his work.</p>
	<p>Breestraat 65</p> <p>1905 Jugendstil in graffito image. Lily with leaf. Image shows 3 girls weighting meat. 7 4 boys with sausages. Original butcher's shop. From 1934 till 1996 the front was covered with paint. Removed during restoration 1996. De Slegte.</p> <p>(Toplevel is covered)</p>	
	<p>Breestraat 90 English mans shop</p>	<p>Jugendstil. 1904. Men's fashion shop. Curved timber supports for windows. Beautiful wrought iron balcony. Iron columns.</p>
	<p>Breestraat 106</p> <p>17th century. Jugendstil front with decorated iron and geometric form and coloured glass in windows. See decorations. Brick around the windows.</p>	
	<p>Breestraat ??</p>	<p>PUUR market in old building</p>

	<p>Langebrug 91</p>	<p>Gekromde Liefdepoort House of Jan Steen</p>

	<p>Lokhorststraat 16:</p>	<p>1599 Latijnse school of Rembrandt</p>
	<p>Kloksteeg (optioneel)</p>	<p>St Pietershofje</p>
	<p>Kloksteeg Voorkant naast de kerk</p>	<p>Jean Persijnhofje 1683. Built on the location of De Groene Poort, where John Robinson, leader of Pilgrim Fathers lived till 1625.</p>
	<p>Pieterskerk open 13.30-16 h?</p>	<p>Pieterskerkhof First church of Leiden 1121.</p>
	<p>Gravensteen</p>	<p>Spinhuis naast Pieterskerkhof. Official building.</p>
	<p>Papengracht</p>	<p>Brouchhovenhofje 1631. At the end the mortuary is in use as storage. The paintings in the head office are now in the Lakenhal.</p>
	<p>Leidse Loper</p>	
	<p>Doelengracht/Doelensteeg</p>	<p>Eva van Hoogeveenshofje 1650. One of the most beautiful almshouses. The sheep of the family coat of arms is on the pump.</p>

		Glass storefront with iron columns. There are 2 buildings above the store. First #8 was built. Then #9 with the store front mirrored. At #8 you find columns in the shop, at #9 these were omitted due to the concrete structure. The curved windows were very modern at that time.	At the left entrance a porcelain tableau of the factory Holland from Utrecht. The typical Jugendstil curve is above the windows.
		Nieuwe Rijnstraat 23 Monument	Neo-Renaissance. Side windows in iron frame and in stone.
		Botermarkt 15 1829 Teak front in neo renaissance style from 1894. started with tearoom in 1870. Up till today in the family.	
		Nieuwe Rijnstraat 27 Best to see from opposite side of canal 1906 Jugendstill: yellow with red brick.	
15.30	15	(optional) St Anna hofje Hooigracht Open sat 14.00- 16.00 h 1492 It has its own medieval chapel, which was not destroyed during the iconoclasm (beeldenstorm). Original altar. In the windows some of the oldest painted glass with weapons medallions of 1492

They flew to Leiden in 1609 seeking asylum; left in 1620 with ship Mayflower to USA. According to Indians the first white Americans. Thanksgiving day is based on Leiden 3 okt day. Bush & Obama have the same ancestors: Elisabeth Blossom from Leiden.</p> <p>The museum is based in the oldest not restored house in Leiden from 14th century. consist of 2 houses. in one a very original floor was recently discovered.</p> <p>Possibility to rest</p>

Siege of Leiden 1573; Dikes were breached to inundate land and stopped the Spanish. At 3 Oct 1573 the Watergeuzen sailed to Leiden. Leidens ontzet. They brought bread and herrings and white bread for the starving population. At 3 Oct the Spanish fled and the people eat Hotchpotch.</p>
